WEEK 1: DO A NEW THING IN ME

DAY 1: SUNDAY, AUGUST 8TH

Prayer Point: Create a New Heart in Me

Scripture Reading: Psalm 51; Ezekiel 11:19-20 NLT

Notes: Pray Psalm 51 from a posture of contrition and repentance. Ask God to give you a tender heart and walk in the grace for this next season that He has for you. Ask God to give you a willing spirit to say yes to whatever plans He has for you around the corner.

DAY 2: MONDAY, AUGUST 9TH

Prayer Point: Renew My Mind and My Thinking

Scripture Reading: Romans 12:1-2 NIV; Isaiah 55:8-13 NIV

Notes: Ask God to show you any areas of your beliefs that don't line up with His word. Ask the Holy Spirit to transform you by renewing your mind. Ask God to increase your faith to trust His word and a better understanding of His heart.

DAY 3: TUESDAY, AUGUST 10TH

Prayer Point: Thank God for his Faithfulness

Scripture Reading: Lamentations 3:22-24 NLT

Notes: Start with a prayer of gratitude for God's faithfulness in your life. Pray Lamentations aloud as a declaration against any forces of darkness that would try to come against you. Tell God exactly where you need His loving mercy every day.

DAY 4: WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 11TH

Prayer Point: Give Me a New Strength

Scripture Reading: Isaiah 40:31 NIV

Notes: Ask God for patience in the waiting areas. Pray for renewed strength, elevated perspective and the courage to rise above the circumstances in your life that are hard. Pray for the ability to discern how to act regarding each situation that you are facing.

DAY 5: THURSDAY, AUGUST 12TH

Prayer Point: Celebrate your New Birth

Scripture Reading: 1 Peter 1:3-5 NLT; 2 Corinthians 5:17-21 NLT

Notes: Give thanks to God for the redemption and new life of being sealed in Christ. Pray for those in your life or in our community that don't know Christ and that they would come to accept Him as Lord. Ask God for selfless and emboldened faith to speak truth in love and to pursue reconciliation of people to God and to one another.

DAY 6: FRIDAY, AUGUST 13TH

Prayer Point: Give Me a New Outpouring

Scripture Reading: Joel 2:28-29 NLT; Acts 1:8 NLT

Notes: Pray for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit in your life. Ask God to give you divine dreams, vision and prophetic insight. Pray that HC would bear a good witness and for revival of both heart and people in the days to come.

DAY 7: SATURDAY, AUGUST 14TH

Prayer Point: A New Future

Scripture Reading: Jeremiah 29:11-14 NIV; Romans 5:1-5 NIV

Notes: Ask God to give you direction over any areas of your life that you are seeking clarity for your future. Ask God what his thoughts about your future look like in the areas of your dreams and desires. Ask God to give you perseverance to stand firm in the things that you feel like God has promised you and your family.

WEEK 2: DO A NEW THING IN MY CHURCH AND COMMUNITY

DAY 8: SUNDAY, AUGUST 15TH

Prayer Point: New Relationships

Scripture Reading: Luke 19:1-9 NET

Notes: Ask God to open your eyes to new spaces for new relationships. Pray to be undeterred when ridiculed for being with those that others don't understand. Ask God to make HC a church and people with Christlike hospitality.

DAY 9: MONDAY, AUGUST 16TH

Prayer Point: New Awareness

Scripture Reading: Nehemiah 1:4-11 NLT

Notes: Pray that your heart will be broken for the condition of people in our city. Pray for our church to "have a mind to work" to get involved in reaching people in our community.

DAY 10: TUESDAY, AUGUST 17TH

Prayer Point: New Support

Scripture Reading: Luke 10:25-37

Notes: Ask God to make you aware of those that you pass as you are "on the way" to whatever you might be doing. Ask God to make you okay with interruptions from your own personal life. Ask God to help you care about those that are in need and never avoid them.

DAY 11: WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 18TH

Prayer Point: A New Story

Scripture Reading: John 4:7-26, 39 NLT

Notes: Ask the Lord how you can engage with others in a way that helps open up conversations about Jesus. Pray that you would have discernment and wisdom about engaging other people. Ask the Holy Spirit to show you needs that you can meet in those people's lives.

DAY 12: THURSDAY, AUGUST 19TH

Prayer Point: A New Imagination

Scripture Reading: Acts 10:9-16, 34-37

Notes: Pray for an open heart to see new things that God is doing in His church and in the world. Ask God to reveal where he's already at work. Ask God to break your heart for those who need Him and for the Holy Spirit to be evident in every way that you interact with others.

DAY 13: FRIDAY, AUGUST 20TH

Prayer Point: A New Action

Scripture Reading: Isaiah 58:6-14 NLT

Notes: Ask God to give you a hunger for prayer and fasting. As you read Isaiah 58, ask God to give you ways that you can fulfill this verse in the community. Pray for our Outreach teams and leadership and ask God for strategic partnerships among the body of Christ to fulfill his commands.

DAY 14: SATURDAY, AUGUST 21ST

Prayer Point: A New Hope

Scripture Reading: Revelation 21:1-5

Notes: Ask God to give you a renewed hope again. Repent for the areas that you've lost hope. Pray for our church and for the Church in America and the world. Pray for the kingdom of God to come to our country.

WEEK 3: DO A NEW THING IN OUR WORLD

DAY 15: SUNDAY, AUGUST 22ND

Prayer Point: Praying for the Persecuted

Scripture Reading: II Corinthians 12:9-10 ESV

Notes: Pray for the persecuted Christ followers around the world. Pray that they would encounter the sufficiency of God's grace like never before. Pray that persecutors would stop and accept Jesus like Saul did. Ask God to tear down the systems, regimes, empires, and beliefs that allow this persecution to exist.

DAY 16: MONDAY, AUGUST 23RD

Prayer Point: Praying for the Unreached

Scripture Reading: Matthew 24:14 ESV; Revelation 7:9 ESV

Notes: Take a few minutes to intercede for the 3.2 billion people in 7,400 people groups who are unreached. Ask the Lord to call and send believers to cross barriers with the gospel. Pray boldly against the spiritual forces that keep people locked in darkness. Pray for our missions' partners around the world. Pray that the unreached would experience encounters with Jesus through dreams, visions, revelations, miracles and divine encounters.

DAY 17: TUESDAY, AUGUST 24TH

Prayer Point: Praying for Laborers

Scripture Reading: Matthew 9:36-38

Notes: Pray that God would send more laborers to join the over 17+ different Dream Teams of HC. Take some time to lift up Dusty, Kendra and all of our pastoral and leadership teams. Pray that God would bring renewed strength and motivation to those who need refilling. Pray for marriages, families and good health for all those who work for the kingdom.

DAY 18: WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 25TH

Prayer Point: Praying for the Poor

Scripture Reading: Matthew 25:34-40 ESV

Notes: Pray for the millions of people facing food insecurity that they will eat daily. Ask God that our heart breaks for those without the basic needs that are needed to live and that we would be a solution to the problem in our city and world. Pray for THE church of Jesus Christ and that His people would be a people that embrace, advocate and care for the global poor.

DAY 19: THURSDAY, AUGUST 26TH

Prayer Point: Praying for Children and Students

Scripture Reading: Matthew 19:13-15

Notes: Ask the Lord to bring revival among children and teenagers in our church and in our world. Ask for sparks of the Holy Spirit to create new movements of young people experiencing revival even in the world's darkest places. Ask God to provide safety and protection for children around the world from predators, traffickers, abusers, exploiters and any who would do them harm.

DAY 20: FRIDAY, AUGUST 27TH

Prayer Point: Praying for Healing

Scripture Reading: James 5:14-16 TLB

Notes: Take time to pray for the sick that you know and you don't know. Pray specifically for those who might be sick as a result of this pandemic. Pray for spiritual unity amongst God's people regarding all of the Covid related issues. Pray for mental and emotional healing for those who are in need.

DAY 21: SATURDAY, AUGUST 28TH

Prayer Point: Praying for Unity

Scripture Reading: Matthew 28:19-20 ESV, Acts 1:8 ESV

Notes: Pray for Global unity in God's church. Ask God that movements and denominations would serve one another as the body of Christ. Pray that the global Christian movement would continue to grow through healthy discipleship, church planting, congregations and missionary vibrancy. Lastly, pray all the same things for Heartland Church. That God would allow people to experience the fullness of the Holy Spirit, and that we would remain rooted in God's word.
